APRIL IS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH



Child abuse and neglect does not discriminate. It can affect anyone, anywhere at anytime. The effects of abuse/neglect can cause trauma that impairs brain development. It also can cause issues in physical development, emotional development and behaviors. These issues may continue later in life.

There are four main types of abuse: neglect, physical, psychological and sexual. Neglect being the most common type of abuse. As mandated reporters it is important the child care professionals know the signs of each type of abuse, as well as when to make a report. Remember, your task is not to prove an incident, but to report suspicions to the proper authorities. The most important task you face as a child care professional is the safety of the children in your care.
