

Right From Birth Child Care Series – Online classes

Family Guidance Center's Child Care Education and Training Program is partnering with Alabama Public Television to offer the Right From Birth Child Care Series. The twelve half-hour episodes lead parents and caregivers through the stages of early childhood from birth to 18 months, giving practical advice on preparing children for a lifetime of learning from the day they are born.

The format for the course is as follows:

- Must have a computer to view the episodes
- Must attend an orientation class via ZOOM
- View the episodes on the APT website (aptv.org/education/right-from-birth)
- Answer the multiple choice and true false questions. Must also complete the extension activities for each episode.
- Return the assignments in a timely manner

If you have an 85% completion for the course, you will receive 12 hours of training. The breakdown of the training hours is as follows:

Child Development	4.0 hours
Health, Safety & Universal Precautions	2.5 hours
Quality Child Care & Licensing	1.0 hours
Language Development	1.5 hours
Positive Discipline & Guidance	3.0 hours
