The Alabama Pathways Professional Development Registry (PDR) will be live on-line **Monday**, **June 17**, **2024**. Early Childhood professionals will once again be using this to register for all classes.

Alabama Pathways is a free online resource to provide a path to support and advance the best practices for those who care for and teach children birth through 12 years of age. In accordance with Alabama Child Care Licensing and Performance Standards, all licensed providers in the State of Alabama are required to participate in the Alabama Professional Development Registry (PDR).

Things to remember:

- A User Guide is always available for your reference on your dashboard.
- When adding information to your profile, go to each tab to add information: education, employment, etc.
- A HELP DESK is available for assistance.
- When setting up your account, use your PERSONAL email. This profile belongs to you.
- As a FINAL step don't forget to associate yourself with the facility at which you are working.
- DIRECTORS Make sure that once you set up your personal profile you also request your DIRECTOR status. This allows you to see your staff's information as well as associate your staff with the center.

Each quarter a PDR training will be offered via ZOOM, one in the morning and one in the evening for those who are new to the PDR or need a refresher course. DATES and TIMES for these trainings are located on the green ZOOM section of the calendar, page 5 and 6.


